Mixed male/female pairs are eligible. Each pair can only enter a particular kata once (it is not permitted to reverse roles).

BOTH COMPETITORS MUST HOLD A CURRENT SENIOR MEMBERSHIP RECOGNISED BY THEIR NATIONAL FEDERATION, WHICH MUST BE PRODUCED ON THE DAY. BRITISH COMPETITORS MUST PRODUCE BJA OR BJC SENIOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE DAY.

JUDOGI CONTROL

There will be Judogi Control prior to booking in. Please note the following:

- Traditional Kodokan standards will be used (Kodokan videos/dvds are available www.fightingfilms.com, www.kodokan.org).
- **Zori or mules must be worn off the mat at all times – not shoes or trainers.**
- Plain white judogi only – no blue or reversible suits.
- Demonstration/replica guns must not have trigger guards.
- No live steel.
- No start numbers on jackets.

In the case of tied places, the Chief Judge will have the casting vote.
Please note that all medal presentations will be made in full judogi (no tracksuits).
