Epsom Judo Club is a local club based in Epsom, Surrey. The club is located at Epsom College in their Sports Centre, the new facilities are fantastic for Judo.

The club is run by Edward Semple and Nicola Gray. Ed is a black belt with both the British Judo Association (BJA) and Amateur Judo Association. He is a Level 2 Judo coach with the BJA and a Level 2 Boxing coach with the Amateur Boxing Association. Ed is also a Level 3 Btech Senior Self Defence Instructor. He has recently written a book on Judo with Ray Stevens, an Olympic Silver medallist. Nicola is a black belt and a Level 2 Judo coach with the BJA. Nicola is also the Head coach for the Surrey female Judo teams.

The club has a strong Junior programme and is ideal for anyone who wants to learn Judo or improve as a Judo player. New members and beginners are always very welcome. The

coaches at the club work hard to make sure that each student improves and develops, whatever their level of ability. Epsom Judo club is a friendly club and is very much part of the local community. The Club is the centre for the Epsom and Ewell Judo squad that competes each year at the Surrey Youth Games.

Last term, members from the club helped to raise over £350 for Samantha Lowe. The funds will help Sam as she prepares for the Olympic Games in London next year. The club ran a throw-a-thon to see how many throws each club member could do in 2 minutes. Afterwards there was a Q&A session with Sam, where we had the opportunity to quiz Sam on her achievements, medals, how she started judo and her experiences of winning a gold medal at the Commonwealth Games.

OBI Tournament



Some time ago Pyrford JC devised an in house competition scheme called the **OBI Tournament** where players of the same ability compete for points. The points add up and convert to grades which are awarded to a small plastic Judoka called the "Obi Man". He has his own web site www.obitournament.com that people can look at. The scheme is already being used in about a dozen clubs including Pyrford, Sovereign and Westcroft.

Squad news below:

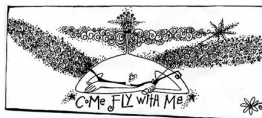

Surrey Has a National Champion !



For only the second time in history, this year's Police Sport UK National Championship was hosted by Surrey Police, the first being ten years ago in 2001. The event was held at the very impressive Surrey Sports Park where the state of the art facilities made the vent one of the most memorable. Over 100



competitors from 24 separate Forces entered the competition from as far afield as Northern Constabulary in Scotland to Devon and Cornwall. The standard of entrant this year was also of the highest calibre with three 5th Dan competitors as well as players who have competed in Commonwealth Games.

Tom Smith, in his first ever competition, put up a really valiant effort in the u100 Kyu grades. Unfortunately the throw he executed with such skill was after the referee had called a halt and was discounted. Tom lost out in his opening contest and then was beaten by the eventual gold medallist from Greater Manchester. A really good effort at such an early stage in his judo career.

Richard Stothard entered both the Veteran's (over 35) and Masters (over 45) categories. Despite some excellent judo and some very close encounters, Richard failed to progress to the medal stages.

Andy Grand, the Tournament Organiser, entered in the Masters under 90 kilo category. Despite losing an early contest by strangle, he succeeded in winning several fights by throwing his opponent for clean ippon, one in only 11 seconds. This ensured a place in the final against the same player he lost to earlier in the day. A very cagey affair ensued with Andy winning his first gold medal on penalties.

Probably the best judo of the day was the final of the Open which saw an under 73 kilo player from Scotland beating a plus 100 kilo player from the West Midlands in the final with a perfect ippon ko-uchi gari, proving that size does not always matter.

A fitting end to a perfect day's competition.

Thanks to all those volunteers and officials that enabled the running this National competition in Surrey.

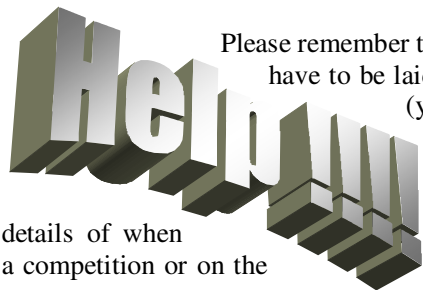

MILLENNIUM LEAGUE PARENTS CAN WIN POINTS FOR THEIR CLUB !

Points are awarded to **NEW VOLUNTEER OFFICIALS** who assist at the League events for Table work, Time Keeping, Scoring or Medical (if qualified). This bonus only applies to those who officiate and are not already qualified competition officials. The points to be awarded are as follows.

- Volunteer officiating at any League events = **5 bonus points**
- Volunteer officiating at all 4 League events = **additional bonus 5 points**
- Maximum number of volunteers per club at any event = **2**
- Maximum number of bonus points available to any one club = **50 points**

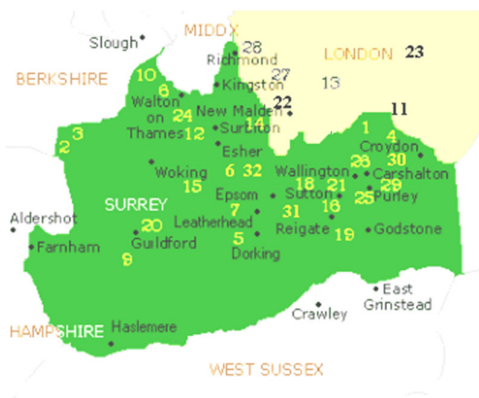

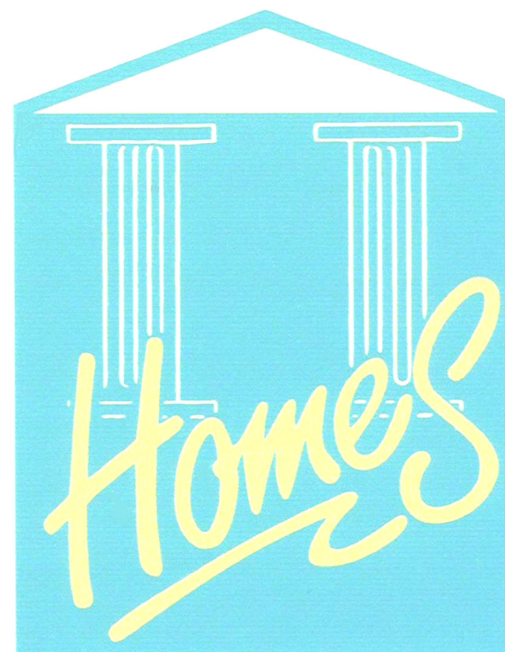
